The "Nederlandse Volksdans Stichting" is 40 years old: Hurrah!

Formation 4C longways set.

Music Scottish/Irish tunes – 18th cent. {40 bars: 32 bar jig (for instance

Drummond Castle) & 8 bar reel}.

- A1 1-4 Inside hands joined, partners lead up and fall back.
 - 5-6 Face partner, fall back.
 - 7-8 Come forward, cross over by R-shoulder.
- A2 1-8 Repeat A1, leading down.
- B1 1 4 R-shoulder chevron with R-diagonal dancer, while the two free endpeople cast into free places at other end of own line. (Chevron R: *R-shoulder back to back with R-diagonal dancer finishing one place to the R in own line).*
 - 5-8 All 1½ R-hand turn with opposite (all improper).
- B2 1-8 Repeat B1, substituting L for each R (3-4-1-2 proper).
- C 1-4 3rd C at top lead down to the bottom, while others fall back from partner, come forward one place up (4-1-2-3).
 - 5-8 All set and turn single R.

Repeat the dance three more times:

 2^{nd} time: A1 & A2 (1 – 4) Siding.

 3^{rd} time: A1 & A2 (1 – 4) Arming R & L.

 4^{th} time: A1 & A2 (1 – 4) Back to back R-sh (A1 men arches; A2 women arches).
