Formation Longways duple minor proper.

Music "Farewell Marian" (♪ Barnes I-38).

- A1 1-4 1st Man does a left shoulder gipsy around the 2nd man, **while** the 1st woman does the same around the 2nd woman.
 - 5-8 Take hands-four with the 2^{nd} couple and circle to the right once around. End 1^{st} couples facing the "men's" wall, 2^{nd} couples facing the "women's" wall.
- A2 1-2 Single file away from the set (1st woman following her partner, 2nd man following his partner).
 - The person in the lead (1st man, 2nd woman) do a U-turn over right shoulder to face partner, and all pass partner right shoulder.
 - 1st Woman and 2nd man do a U-turn over right shoulder to face partner's back, while 1st man and 2nd woman continue to the other side of the set. All are in partner's original place, 1st couples facing "women's" wall, 2nd couples facing "men's" wall.
 - 5-8 In fours right hands across once around.
- B1 1-4 2nd Man and 1st woman (= people in 1st corners' places) set to each other and change places.
 - 5-8 1st Man and 2nd woman do the same.
- B2 1-4 With partner: back-to-back.
 - 5-8 Two-hand turn partner. End in progressed places, 1^{st} couples ready to gipsy left their new neighbours.

For Toos Heesakkers, celebrating both her 60th birthday and her retirement. Toos adores dances on beautiful waltz tunes.

With a bit of imagination, you can see a number "six" in A1 1 - 4 and a "zero" in A1 5 - 8. Together this makes "60".
